<p><b>This term we will be looking at two topics in maths; decimals and money:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><b>Decimals:</b> We will be working with tenths and hundredths before rounding and comparing decimals.</li><li><b>Money:</b> We will be ordering and estimating money in pounds and pence.</li></ul> <p>We will also be focusing on our times tables ahead of the MTC.</p>	<p>This term we will be reading the book 'The BFG'.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>We will be working on our descriptive writing and also writing recipes.</li><li>We will also be focusing heavily on our cursive handwriting.</li></ul>	<p><b>Our topic for science this term is 'Living Things'.
