#### **Catholic Life of the School and Federation news**

Our joint Lenten reflection this morning allowed us to reflect on the people we meet through Good Friday and how the feel as part of the Easter Story. We ask the children to reflect and look at for those in need.

Palm Sunday is the final Sunday of Lent, the beginning of Holy Week, and commemorates the triumphant arrival of Christ in Jerusalem, days before he was crucified. We will be reacting this for the children in school on Monday.

In the Gospels, Jesus entered Jerusalem riding a young donkey, and to the lavish praise of the townspeople who threw clothes, or possibly palms or small branches, in front of him as a sign of homage. This was a customary practice for people of great respect.

Palm branches are a widely recognised symbol of peace and victory, hence their preferred use on Palm Sunday.

The use of a donkey instead of a horse is highly symbolic, it represents the humble arrival of someone in peace.

We wish you a peaceful Easter holiday and look forward to seeing you all return safely on Tuesday 16th April.


