



<p>Year 4 will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Deepening their understanding of fractions to understand equivalence, improper fractions and mixed numbers, addition and subtraction of fractions and finding fractions of an amount. - Understanding place value past the decimal point, learning about tenths and hundredths <p>At home: Ensure to continue practicing times tables up to 12 x 12, in preparation for the MTC. Keep up to date with Mathematics tasks.</p>	<p>Year 4 will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Exploring a series of educational graphic novels that teach science through the adventures of a superhero scientist called Max Axiom. - Writing an explanation text <p>At home: - Visit your local library to find other graphic novel/comic style books that are suitable for year 4s.</p>	<p>Year 4 will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Learning about sound – how it is made, how it is heard and understanding how different vibrations create different pitch. <p>At home: Experiment with creating different sounds using our body, instruments and household items – paying attention to the vibrations that are creating that sound.</p>

<p>Year 4 will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Learning about Pentecost, and how the power of the Holy Spirit was in the lives of the disciples at this time. We will be looking at scripture from the book of Paul, and considering how his actions and beliefs are important to Catholics. <p>At home:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Think about how we can spread good news to your friends, family and others in your community. - Attend your local church service on a Sunday. 	<p>Year 4 will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Experimenting with marbling printing, choosing appropriate marble colours and making marble backgrounds for further pictures/printing. <p>At home: Research the paintings of the Amazon by Henri Rousseau & Nixiwaka Yawanawa. You could even try drawing/painting your own animal pictures.</p>	<p>Year 4 will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Learning about the Anglo-Saxons – when and why they invaded Britain, and why this period of history is remembered as the dark age. <p>At home: Consider visiting the Museum of London, or the Victoria and Albert Museum which feature Anglo-Saxon artefacts.</p>
