





Maths	English	Science
<p>Fractions: We will understand denominators and numerators, unit and non-unit fractions and counting in fractions on a number line</p> <p>Mass and Capacity: We will begin this term in maths by looking at mass and capacity. We will learn to measure grams and kilograms in mass and then ml and l in capacity. We will also be adding and subtracting both.</p> <p>How can you help your child at home? Complete <i>Mathletics</i> tasks each week and to do 10 minutes of <i>TT Rockstars</i> daily.</p>	<p>This term we will be learning about the life and work of William Shakespeare. We will be reading an adapted version of his play 'Midsummer Night's Dream'. Children will also be exposed to a range of traditional fairy tales as we prepare for narrative writing in the next half term. How can you help your child at home? Reading fairy tales with your child is a great way to expose them to the features of fairy tales and help prepare them for creating characters and setting descriptions.</p>	<p>Forces and Magnets</p> <p>In this unit, pupils will compare how objects move on different surfaces and explore how materials affect motion. They will investigate magnets, learning how they attract and repel, and explore magnetic forces through hands-on activities. Finally, they will look at everyday uses of magnets, including in household items and electronics.</p>
