





Maths	English	Science

Challenge children to read the time from clocks and watches. Work out the cost of different items when shopping.</p>	<p>Year 4 will be:</p> <p>Studying and reading Varjak Paw by S.F. This will include different types of energy and how we can reduce waste <p>At home: Show the children how to recycle different items correctly, and ways that we can conserve food, water and energy.</p>



Music

Year 4 will be:

Developing our Ukelele skills, playing a range of different chords and learning the rhythm to play different songs together as a class.

At home:

Listening to music featuring string instruments such as the ukulele, guitar, violin or others. Compare the different styles of music and different sounds produced by these instruments.

Year 4 will be:

Exploring in greater detail the community aspect of the Trinity and encourages children to think about what the Trinity means to them and how as they were made in God's image, they too are created to live in community.

We will also revisit previous learning about money and how to manage money including different payment methods, budgeting and keeping track of spending and how our choices can impact on our lives and the lives of others.
